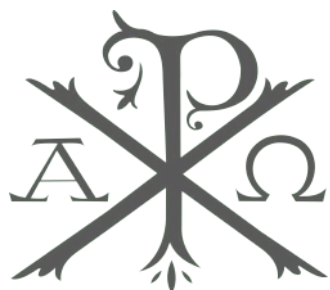

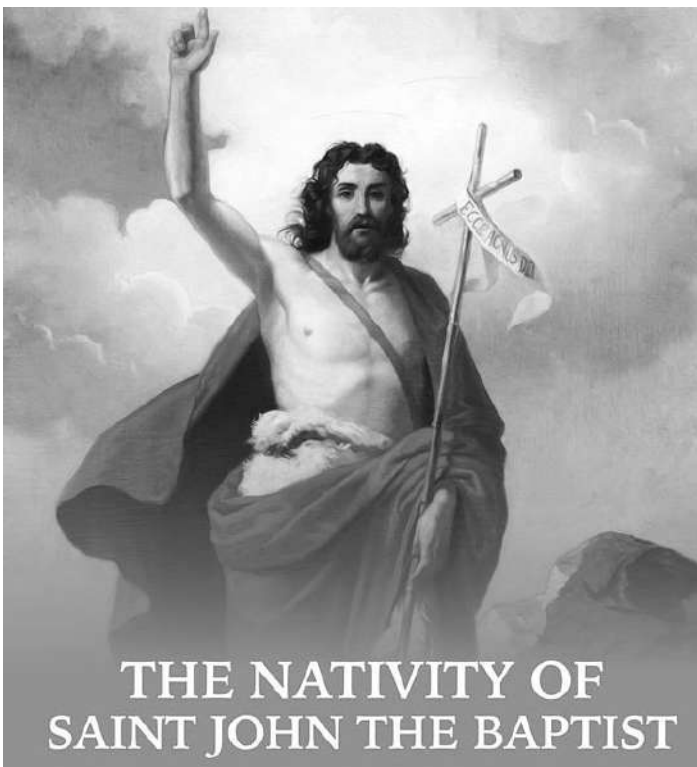
Lord, you made me your child not only for my personal happiness, not for my own advancement, but to entrust me with a particular mission within your plan of salvation. Lord, help me

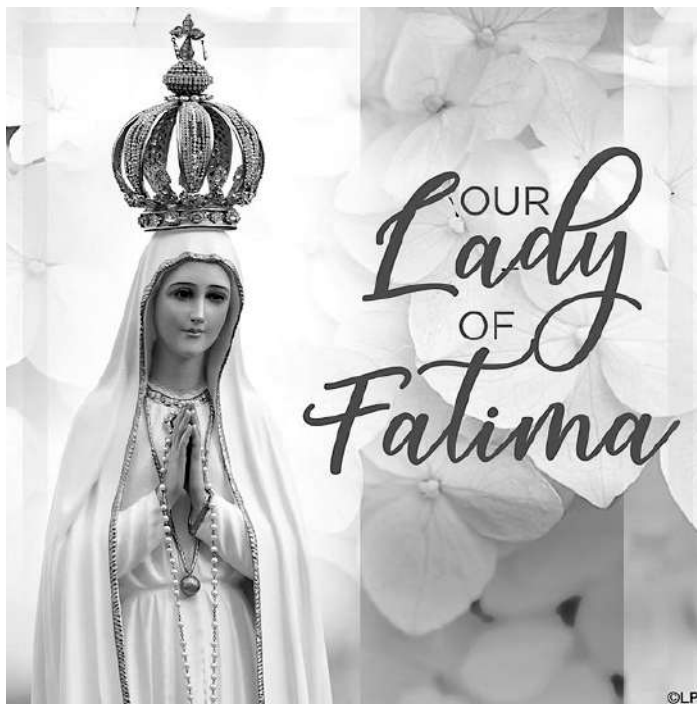

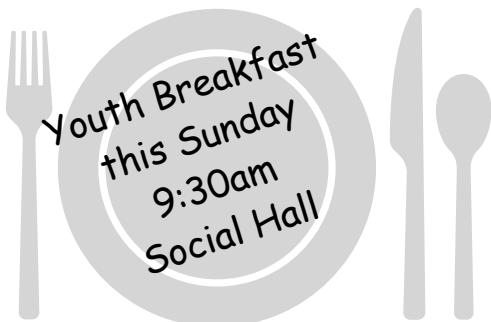
CONGRATULATIONS TO HAYDEN RAINES

The Naming of St. John the Baptist
