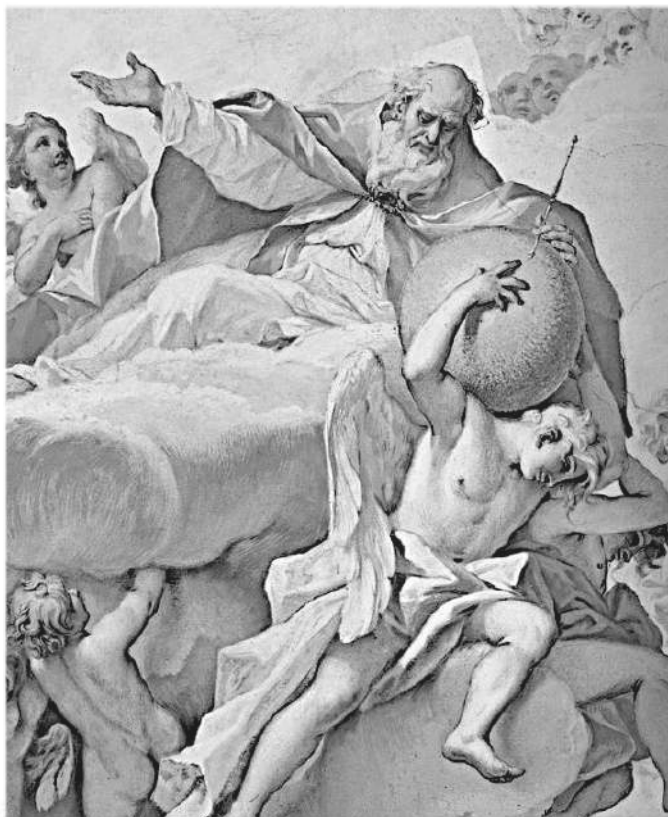
ALWAYS READY FOR THE HOUR

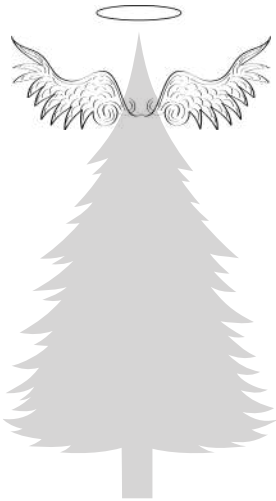
